## FOUNDATIONAL SKILLS

Print Concepts - Demonstrate understanding of the organization and basic features of print

**Phonological Awareness -** Demonstrate understanding of spoken words, syllables, and sounds

**Phonics and Word Recognition -** Know and apply grade-level phonics and word analysis skills in decoding words

Fluency - Read emergent reader text with purpose and understanding

LITERATURE AND INFORMATION

**Key Ideas and Details -** With prompting and support identify characters, settings, main idea, events or details and make connections

**Craft and Structure -** Ask and answer questions about unknown words, parts of a text, recognize the structure/type of books, identify what the author and illustrator do

**Integration of Knowledge and Ideas –** With support, describe how the illustrations connect to the text; identify reasons that support points; compare and contrast two texts

**Vocabulary Acquisition and Use** - Use words and phrases acquired, determine or clarify meaning of unknown words based on grade-level reading and content

**Range of Reading and Level of Text Complexity** - Actively engage in group reading activities

Focus - remains on topic

**Organization -** directionality and spacing

Content - picture with details and labels

Sentence Construction - at least one simple sentence

**Mechanics -** appropriate use of capital and lowercase letters

**Spelling and Grammar -** correctly spelled sight words, clear meaning, and appropriate grammar

## SPEAKING AND LISTENING

**Comprehension and Collaboration -** Participate properly in conversations in order to share ideas, get information, or clarify understanding

**Presentation of Knowledge and Ideas -** Identify word meaning and how words connect to each other; use new words learned when writing and speaking
