HAHS Notes and Updates

MP 2/Semester 1 Dates

- The last day of Marking Period 2/Semester 2 is Wednesday, 1/20. Learners should have all course assignments submitted to teachers by the end of the semester
- MP2 grades/report cards will be released on Thursday, 1/28

MP3/Semester 2 Dates

- Both Red and Blue Group learners will begin their MP3/Semester 2 classes on Thursday, 1/21, regardless of learning model
- Learners must check Skyward for their daily schedule, check their email for any correspondence from teachers, and check their Google Classrooms for class invites
 - This is especially important for courses that change between Semester 1 and Semester 2, which primarily impacts electives
- Learners will receive a hard copy of their Semester 2 schedule during their first in-person day in homeroom

Student Drivers

- Learners are reminded to arrive to school by 7:45 am so that we can facilitate our arrival and temperature checking procedures
- This is especially important at the start of the second semester, as learners will be receiving important information during the homeroom timeframe

Materials Return

- Learners should be prepared to return any materials from Semester 1 classes during their first day of a return to in-person learning
- Morning time will be provided to return resources to Semester 1 teachers

HCCTC

- The first day for HAHS learners to attend the HCCTC is Thursday, 1/21
- All HCCTC learners should attend the CTC each school day
- Learners should follow their blended/hybrid plans for HCCTC transportation as they have followed previously this year during their non HAHS in-person days
