FOUNDATIONAL SKILLS

Print Concepts-Understanding of organization and basic features of print

Phonological Awareness-Demonstrates understanding of spoken words, syllables and sounds

Phonics and Word Recognition-Know and apply grade level phonics and word analysis skills in decoding words

Fluency-Read first grade level text with accuracy and fluency to support comprehension

LITERATURE AND INFORMATION

Key Ideas and Details-Identify the main idea and key details in a text; retell the details to show understanding of the central message or topic; make connections between text, characters events or ideas in a text

Craft and Structure- Know and use various text features to locate key information in an informational text; Identify who is telling the story; Explain major differences between books that tell stories and books that give information; Ask and answer questions to help determine or clarify the meaning of words/phrases in a text

Integration of Knowledge and Ideas-Use illustrations and details in a text to describe key ideas; identify reasons an author gives to support points; compare and contrast between two texts or character experiences

Vocabulary Acquisition and Use-Determine the meaning of unknown and multiple-meaning words and phrases; uses words and phrases acquired through conversation, reading and being read to and responding to texts

Instructional Reading Level

WRITING

Focus-writing is on topic and focused

Content-writing has an adequately organized structure; there is a progression of ideas from beginning to end with transitional strategies; adequate introduction and conclusion

Organization-writing has adequate main idea(s) with supporting details and descriptions

Style- writing is adequately expressed and includes adjectives and a variety of word choice

Conventions-writing has few grammatical errors; adequate use of punctuation, capitalization, and spelling

SPEAKING AND LISTENING

Comprehension and Collaboration-Participates in collaborative conversations with peers and adults; Confirms understanding of a text read aloud or information presented orally; Asks and answer questions about what a speaker is saying

Presentation of Knowledge and Ideas-Describe people, places, things and events with relevant details, expressing ideas and feelings clearly; produces complete sentences

Integration of Knowledge and Ideas-Add drawings or other visual displays when sharing aloud to clarify ideas, thoughts and feelings

Conventions of Standard English-Demonstrates command of the conventions of standard English, when speaking, based on Grade 1 level and content
