If you scan photos for the staff, please be sure it is in JPEG format and scan it at 300 dpi, however, it is preferred that you send the original photos. Our staff will lay out the ad. The staff will arrange your information in the most esthetically pleasing way possible to fill the space you purchase. **We will be able to return any photos to you after we are finished with them. Simply include a self-addressed, stamped envelope and a note stating what items you would like to have returned to you. Your information will be returned in early May. If I do not receive an envelope, I will return the information directly to your student.**

Your ads will be yearbook quality, so we encourage you to look at previous yearbooks for further examples. We hope you will purchase an ad for your senior. Don’t forget to share the information with other family members too! Messages from grandparents, brothers, sisters, or aunts and uncles are welcome. AD DIMENSIONS AND OPTIONS

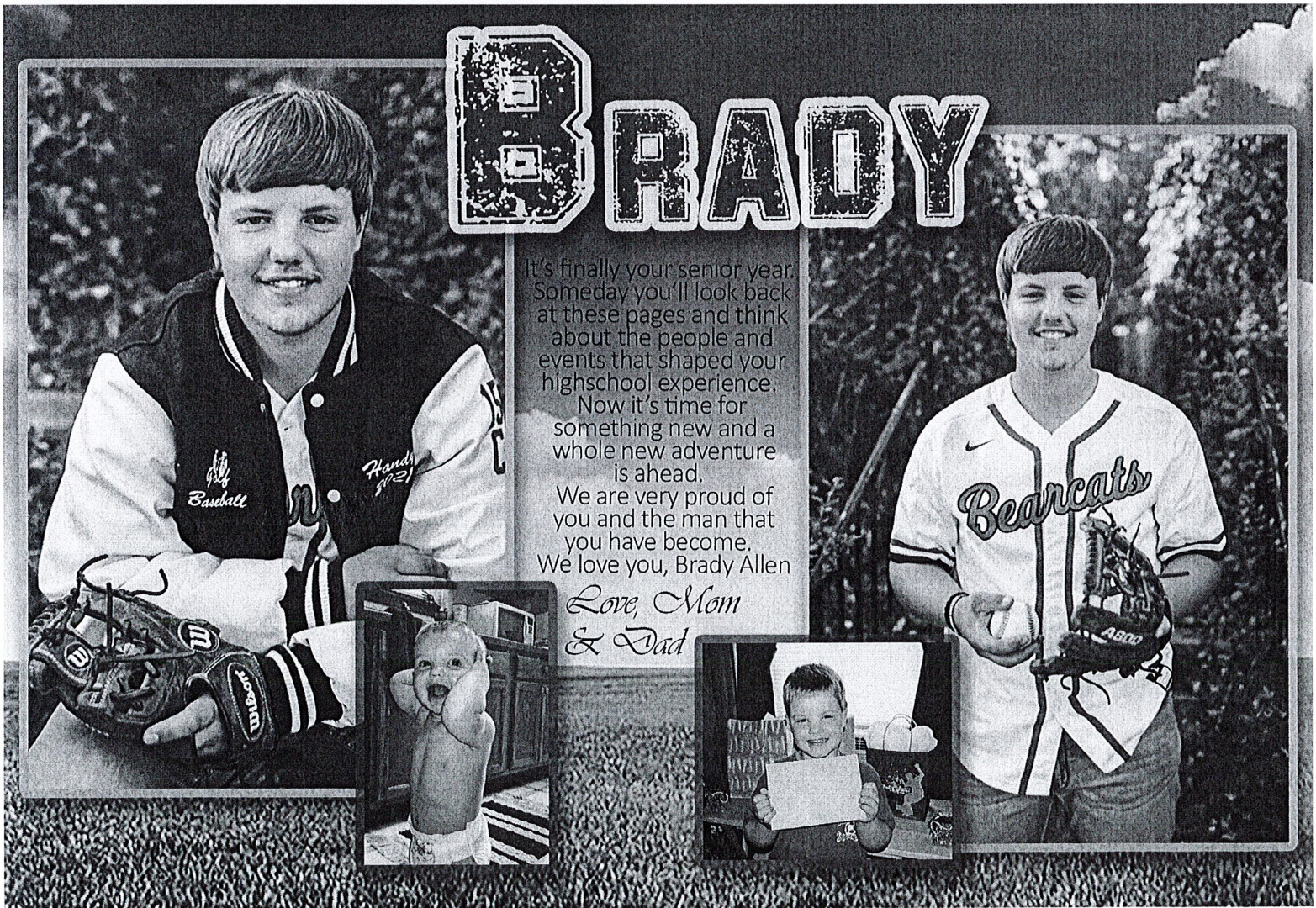
When considering the ads for your student, you may purchase an eighth page, quarter page, half page, or whole page. The costs, sizes, maximum amount of information that will fit in the ad, and approximate format on a whole page for these dimensions are as follows:

	<u>Approximate Size (in inches)</u>	<u>Cost</u>
<i>Quarter-page:</i>	<i>4 ¼ X 5 ½</i>	<i>\$60.00</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Up to four pictures• No more than 5 sentences and/or quotes	
<i>Half-page:</i>	<i>8 ½ X 5 ½</i>	<i>\$120.00</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Up to 6 pictures• A paragraph can be included• Several quotes if desired• Up to 2 different messages	
<i>Whole-page:</i>	<i>8 ½ X 11</i>	<i>\$200.00</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maximum of 8 photos• Limited number of messages, within reason
