Dear Parents and/or Guardians of the Class of 2026,

We know you have been preparing for your child's senior year for quite a while now, and we want to do our best to make the process of submitting senior pictures for the yearbook easy for you. This letter is designed to provide information about senior picture submission.

You are welcome to choose any photographer that you would like or take the pictures yourself, but we ask that you follow the criteria listed below - PLEASE no selfies! Once you have decided which photographer to use for senior portraits, the next decision is which photo to choose for use in the yearbook. The portrait submitted for the yearbook **MUST** be a head and shoulder shot of the student **ONLY**. The portrait may be taken in a studio or outside, but the prominent object in the picture must be the head and shoulders only of the student. We want to focus on the students to create valuable memories for years to come.

Photo submission from photographers:

- You **MUST** turn in your photo by **Tuesday, November 25, 2025**. **Late submissions may not be accepted.**
- **The photo submitted must be a COLOR head and shoulder shot of the student only with appropriate school attire. Please do your best to submit one that has no extra animals or objects in the picture, for consistency and quality.**
- We would appreciate it if we could receive your picture in a digital format – a flash drive or CD is acceptable. You are also welcome to e-mail them to me (see address below),
- You may ask your photographer to send the picture directly to me. That has also been efficient in the past. Please do not send a link to an entire album of pictures. Often the photographer has “locked” the pictures so we cannot access them.
- When sending a digital copy, it must be in a JPEG format of at least 300 DPI and no larger than 5000 KB
- We will also accept an actual picture that we can scan, but the quality will not be as high with a reproduction.

PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT A PHOTO TAKEN WITH A CELL PHONE, and WE WILL NOT PRINT “SELFIES”.

If you are interested in this once in a lifetime opportunity to wish your high school graduate well in the future, please send your message, pictures, and/or art work to the high school office in care of Mr. Patrick/ARGUS Staff. Please send only original pictures and general designs.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND SCANNED PHOTOS UNLESS YOU SAVE THEM TO A DISK.

If you scan photos for the staff, please be sure it is in JPEG format and scan it at 300 dpi; however, it is preferred that you send the original photos. Our staff will lay out the ad. The staff will arrange your information in the most esthetically pleasing way possible to fill the space you purchase. **We will be able to return any photos to you after we are finished with them. Simply include a self-addressed, stamped envelope and a note stating what items you would like to have returned to you. Your information will be returned in early May. If I do not receive an envelope, I will return the information directly to your student.**

Your ads will be yearbook quality, so we encourage you to look at previous yearbooks for further examples. We hope you will purchase an ad for your senior. Don’t forget to share the information with other family members too! Messages from grandparents, brothers, sisters, or aunts and uncles are welcome.

The deadline for all submissions is **Tuesday, Nov. 25, 2025.** Please understand that this information must have arrived to the school by the close of school on this date. Any late submissions **MAY NOT** appear in the yearbook. You may send your information to school with the student; however, many relatives choose to keep the ad a secret.

DON’T DELAY!!! Money and ALL ad information is required to get a spot.

AD DIMENSIONS AND OPTIONS

When considering the ads for your student, you may purchase a quarter page, half page, or whole page. The costs, sizes, maximum amount of information that will fit in the ad, and approximate format on a whole page for these dimensions are as follows:

Approximate Size (in inches)/ Cost

Quarter-page: 4 ¼ X 5 ½ \$60.00

- Up to four pictures
- No more than 5 sentences and/or quotes

Half-page: 8 ½ X 5 ½ \$120.00

- Up to 6 pictures
- A paragraph can be included
- Several quotes if desired
- Up to 2 different messages

Whole-page: 8 ½ X 11 \$200.00

- Maximum of 8 photos
- Limited number of messages, within reason
