WOODCOCK VALLEY LIONS SCHOLARSHIP 2017-2018

The recipient of the Woodcock Valley Lions Club Scholarship will be chosen with the following criteria in mind: the student's needs, academic performances, leadership skills, citizenship, and recommendations from the persons stated in item two under academic information. This scholarship is available to students who will be members of the 2018 graduating class of Huntingdon Area High School and the Tussey Mountain High School.

Each school district will narrow its choices to four and submit the names of these finalists to the Woodcock Valley Lions Club Scholarship Committee, 18856 Raystown Road, James Creek, Pa. 16657. All of the student's applications must be forwarded to the committee. The Woodcock Valley Lions Club Scholarship Committee will evaluate the candidates of each school and make the final selection. Two scholarships are available at each school. Most education resulting in job skills will be eligible.

Winners of the scholarships will be announced at the schools awards day or graduation. The scholarship will be applied to second semester tuition payment upon the successful completion of the first semesters study. Each scholarship is worth \$1000.00

The students who receive scholarships must present to the Woodcock Valley Lions at the end of the first semester of school, an official grade transcript, copy of billing from the college, or if the bill has been paid by the parents, a receipt from the college indicating that the bill has been paid for the second semester. We suggest payment to student or parent.

In addition, **the students receiving scholarships will need to be guests**, along with their parents if they wish to come, at a dinner meeting of the club to be introduced to the club members. This meeting would be held **Thursday June 21, 2018 at 7:00 P.M.** at the Lions building. The Lion Club also requires an individual picture for use in our scrapbook, possible display in the hall, or for use in news publications. Student attendance is required.
