

# Second Grade ELA Informational Sheet

<b>FOUNDATIONAL SKILLS</b>
<b>Phonics and Word Recognition</b> - Know and apply grade level phonics skills to decoding words; read grade level high frequency sight words and Trick words
<b>Fluency</b> - Read text orally with accuracy, appropriate rate, and expression; use text to confirm or self correct words while reading
<b>LITERATURE AND INFORMATION</b>
<b>Key Ideas and Details</b> - Identify main ideas or central theme; answer questions about text; describe the connection between events, concepts, or steps in a procedure; describe how characters respond to changes
<b>Craft and Structure</b> - locate key facts or information; determine the meaning of words and phrases in text; describe how words and phrases supply rhythm and meaning in poems; discuss beginning, middle, and end of a story
<b>Integration of Knowledge and Ideas</b> - Explain how graphic representations contribute to text; describe how reasons support specific points; compare and contrast texts on similar topics; demonstrate understanding of characters, setting, or plot
<b>Vocabulary Acquisition and Use</b> - Use grade-appropriate conversational, academic, and domain specific words and phrases; determine the meaning of unknown and multiple-meaning words and phrases

<b>WRITING</b>
<b>Focus</b> - writing is on topic and focused
<b>Organization</b> - writing has an adequately organized structure; there is an progression of ideas from beginning to end with transitional strategies; adequate introduction and conclusion
<b>Content</b> - writing has adequate main idea(s) with supporting details and descriptions
<b>Style</b> - writing is adequately expressed and includes adjectives and a variety of word choice

**Conventions** - writing has few grammatical errors; adequate use of punctuation, capitalization, and spelling

**Comprehension and Collaboration** - Participate properly in conversations in order to share ideas, get information, or clarify understanding

**Knowledge and Ideas** - Use relevant facts or details; add more details through descriptions or drawings; speak clearly to express ideas and feelings
