Dear Parents/Guardians:

For the week starting on Sunday, January 17, 2021, the Standing Stone Elementary administration has been informed of the following staff members or learners that had tested positive for Covid-19:

- January 21, 2021: One learner and six school participants have been identified as a close contact.

In collaboration with the Department of Health, contact investigating was completed by the administration throughout the day upon notification of the positive test results. At this time all those who were identified as a close contact have been notified by the district administration or nurse via a personal phone call.

As per the Pennsylvania Department of Education website, a “close contact” is defined as individuals who have been exposed (within 6 feet distance for at least 15 consecutive minutes) to someone who has been infected by the virus and it is unknown if the close contact will go on to develop Covid-19. All parents/guardians of learners that were in “close contact” have been contacted directly by the building administration or nurses prior to the release of this letter. If you have not been notified at this time, then you are not considered a close contact by the school district.

The Huntingdon Area School District administration has been and will continue to be in communication with the Department of Health (DOH). The administration will monitor all situations regarding Covid-19 and will keep parents/guardians informed.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. We greatly appreciate the support of all of our families during this time of COVID 19.
