### **Updates and Info**

- **Unified Bocce Home Match**
  - The first home meet for the HAHS Unified Bocce team is this Wednesday, 1/26, at 4:00 pm in the HS Gymnasium
  - We hope to have a great turn-out from the student body and our school community to support our team that has worked very hard. Please wear your Bearcat Red and Blue on Wednesday and come to support our team in an uplifting and positive manner!
- **Quarantine Expectations for Students**
  - When students are required to quarantine, it is important that they continue with their academic work. They should continue to submit virtual assignments by the established deadlines, and communicate with teachers regarding any paper assignments
  - When a student quarantines, they should be monitoring their Google Classroom for information and assignments and monitoring their email
    - Students should begin by reviewing their Weekly agenda, and any postings for a specific day, within Google Classroom
    - Students will receive a message from the HS Office, with their teachers copied, explaining this information. Students should be reaching out to their teachers regarding any specific questions, and teachers will communicate any additional items not found within the agenda or Classroom
  - If a student is ill while quarantining, they should notify the office so that an absence can be recorded. Otherwise, students should be completing their work at home
  - Masking
    - When students return after 5 days of quarantine, they are required to mask for an additional 5 days. Students that will not mask, and wear them appropriately, will need to quarantine at home for an additional 5 days.
    - The exact dates of quarantine and masking will be communicated by the school nurse and/or the HS Office

- **Marking Period 2 Report Cards**
  - Report cards for Marking Period 2 were posted today. They are available via the Skyward Family Access Portal
  - We delayed the release due to the completion of grades from students that were quarantining. We appreciate your patience
- **HCCTC Applications**
  - A message is posted on the HAHS website and shared in the Grade Level Google Classrooms regarding applications for the Huntingdon County Career and Technology Center
  - Students only need to apply if they will be a new student at the HCCTC next school year
