

SUBJECT: **Baccalaureate and Commencement**

Baccalaureate and Commencement are important parts of the completion of the high school career. These events serve as the final times that the Class of 2022 will be formally recognized. All seniors are requested to be at Baccalaureate and Commencement. This is an important achievement for learners, and a time for families and friends to join in recognizing this accomplishment, so attendance is important. If unable to attend Commencement, you must be excused in advance by May 20, 2022. If learners wish to participate in a small private graduation ceremony, please notify Mrs. Fouse and Mr. Lee by May 20, 2022.

Rehearsal for Baccalaureate and Commencement will be on Tuesday, May 31, at 8:00 a.m. in the auditorium, Wednesday, June 1, and Thursday, June 2, at 8:00 a.m. with Mr. Lee and Mrs. Fouse directing activities at War Vets Field. Attendance at rehearsals is **mandatory**. After the Commencement rehearsal on May 31, seniors will be notified of outstanding debts that must be paid prior to Commencement.

Baccalaureate will be held on Tuesday, May 31, in the high school auditorium at 7:00 p.m. Graduates will assemble in the cafeteria at 6:15 p.m. to receive any last minute instructions. Your caps should be level with the tassels on the left side. During the prayer, men should remove their caps.

Commencement will be held on Thursday, June 2 at War Vets Field at 7:00 p.m. The event will also be livestreamed. All seniors must report to the fieldhouse by 6:00 p.m. for special instructions. Name cards will be distributed at this time, and processional lines will be formed by 6:45 p.m. We strongly suggest that you leave no money or valuables unattended during the ceremony.

In the case of inclement weather, the HAHS gymnasium will be used for Commencement. Each student will receive ten (10) tickets for Commencement during commencement practice. When Commencement is held at the high school, tickets are needed. Ticket holders only will be admitted until 6:45 p.m.; then the gymnasium will be open to the public. If you have any questions, please get in touch with me at your earliest convenience.

For Baccalaureate and Graduation: Gowns must be "in press" for this occasion with men wearing dark trousers and black shoes and ladies wearing appropriate shoes (no flip flops, must have heel or heel strap). Tassels should be on the left and caps worn level. During the National Anthem and Alma Mater, men should remove their caps.

For you to participate in Commencement, all graduation requirements must be completed by May 26. If you are unable to pass all requirements, you will not walk with your class; instead, you will receive your diploma at a later time. Due to past incidents of misconduct involving beach balls and other distasteful displays, any students performing acts that diminish the proper decorum of this dignified ceremony will have their diplomas withheld until appropriate consequences have been fulfilled. Please note that the Commencement ceremony is to be an important event for the graduating students, the school, and the community, and therefore proper decorum is expected.
