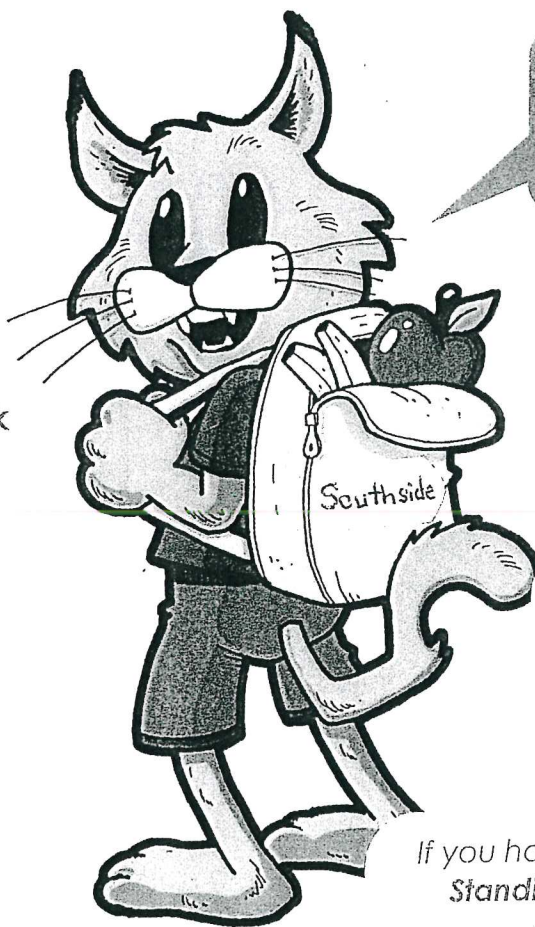

Huntingdon Area School District's Care Team runs a backpack program to help families by providing food and snacks for the weekend. 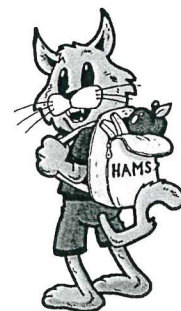
