

For Pre-K Counts

The Huntingdon Area School District is currently accepting applications for the 2023-2024 School Year for our Pre-K Counts Program. Children must be 3 years of age before September 1, 2023 and cannot be 5 years of age before September 1, 2023.

The Pre-K Counts Program is located at Southside Elementary School. Children attend Monday through Friday during the normal school day and follow the Huntingdon Area School District calendar. Transportation is provided for all Pre-K students that live in the Huntingdon Area School District.

At this time, we have income eligible spots available. We also have available spots for regular payment. The cost for the 2023-24 school year will be \$20 a day for 180 days or \$30 a day for two or more children for 180 days. Transportation is provided if you live in the district as well as breakfast. Lunch can be purchased from the school cafeteria.
