HASD Password Change Needed



All HASD students are required to complete a password change by 12/23/25 to maintain account security. Students in grades 7-12 and their families should carefully read the email sent on 12/11/25 for instructions, as action is required. Elementary students will complete this hands-on with their BILD teachers, and no action is needed at home.

Grades 7–8:


- Students may enroll full-time or hybrid by attending an enrollment session. Families must email Mrs. Young by 1/2/26 to get started.
